Hello group. Starting Wed. September 12th, Samaritan Behavioral Health will be staffing a Opioid/Drug Intervention Service (OIS) Nurse in the MVH Main ED. This is a pilot process and will start with on-site coverage M, W, F 10am-7pm. Attached is entire workflow for you to review if interested, but basics of process below.

Process for consultation:

- 1. Screen for patient interest in drug treatment intervention--provider or nurse.
- 2. Consult Social Services regarding interest in drug treatment intervention (same as current process).
- 3. Social Services contacts OIS nurse for consultation.
- 4. OIS nurse evaluates patient and provides options and resources for drug intervention services.
- 5. OIS nurse/social services closes loop with provider.
- ***On days and times the OIS nurse is not at the ED, the ED Social Worker could call the OIS nurse directly (503-2009) on the patient's room phone and give the phone to the patient. The nurse will talk to the patient directly to facilitate linkage to services. The OIS nurse will obtain the MVH Social Workers contact information at the beginning of the call. After speaking with the patient, the OIS RN will contact social worker to inform them of the plan for the patient.

I think this is a great resource for our patients and for our department that I hope we are able to take full advantage of.
